Printing Your Digital Purchase

Why are there blank pages?

When you open the pdf containing your purchase, you may notice a blank page or two (especially if you've ordered a planner). This blank page(s) is there to allow for quick and easy double sided printing.

What type of paper should I use?

I suggest using 28 lb. paper to prevent transparency in printing planners or my other printables. If you have purchased a planner, you may wish to use cardstock to print the cover. You may like to choose a lighter or heavier paper depending on how your purchase will be used.

General Printing Instructions

1. Download the files from your Etsy purchase
2. Open the planner file you purchased.
3. Select double sided printing as well as your printer's best resolution.
4. ENJOY!

What printer settings should I use?

Use your printer's highest resolution for the best results. The planner is set up for double sided printing.

Printing problems

Each customer's printer is different and, as such, I'm not always able to provide support. Please research how to print your product on your individual printer.

How should I store or bind my planner?

The cheapest way to store your planner is to 3 hole punch your document and store it in a binder. You can also use other special punching and binding equipment you have on hand.

Another inexpensive option is to take the printed document to your local office supply store (ex. Staples) where they will be able to bind it inexpensively (approximately \$5). They will also be able to print the document, though this will be much more expensive than printing it at home.

If you choose to have your planner printed elsewhere, I suggest your local print shop as they are much more reasonably priced and (usually!) easier to work with!
